## **Rules and Expectations:**

- The use of Tobacco is <u>STRICTLY</u> prohibited during the IMUN'25 Conference, this includes vapes, cigarettes, or any type of Tobacco. If these products are found with anyone during the conference, they will be confiscated and **NOT returned.**
- The possession of alcohol will not be tolerated. If found on a participant's person, not only will the alcohol be confiscated, but the participant's school will be contacted. This participant will immediately be removed from the conference *without receiving a refund*.
- The excessive use of phones during sessions is prohibited, chairing panels reserve the right to confiscate phones and other electronic devices if used inappropriately.
- Any forms of bullying or mockery are not tolerated in the conference.
- Participants are expected to be punctual.
- All participants are to adhere to the dress code stated below.
- If delegates are required to leave or arrive late at the conference at any point due to an <u>emergency</u>, they must communicate with their President, the Secretariat Team, the IMUN Coordinator, and the Coordinator of the Delegate's school.

## Please note that:

- The IMUN team values the safety and well being of the participants and expects the delegates to comply with the rules and regulations.
- The IMUN Secretariat Team and IMUN Coordinator reserve the right to remove any participant from the conference if the rules and expectations are breached.
- Parents will be contacted in case of an emergency and any necessary arrangements will be made while adhering to the conference policies and procedures.

## **Dress Code For Females:**

Females are to adhere to a business formal dress code, this includes blazers, suits, formal pants and appropriate tops. Jewelry is permitted if not excessive. Participants are obligated to refrain from violating the following guidelines:

- Strapless tops, as well as crop tops, tube tops, low cuts, sleeveless tops, off-shoulder tops, spaghetti-strapped tops are strictly prohibited if worn without an overgarment.
- Micro-mini, mini, and above the knee skirts are not allowed.
- Knee-length skirts must be worn with tights.
- Undergarments should not be seen.
- Female participants are <u>advised</u> not to wear heels.

## **Dress Code for Males:**

Those attending are required to wear a blazer, formal pants, dress shoes, and a formal shirt. It is advised that male attendees wear a tie. Male attendees should NOT wear:

- Casual Clothing (Jeans, Tshirts, ETC.),
- Sports, Sleeping or active clothing,
- Military or national clothes.
